**Trail Crew positions:** stationed at a remote location, heavy maintenance and repair of trails, self-contained backpack crew, camped out in the field during work week.

**Weed Crew positions:** complete inventory, treatment and monitoring of noxious weeds, self-contained backpack crew, camped out in the field during work week.

**Wilderness & Recreation Techs:** stationed at one of several remote stations, work independently, visitor contact and education, backcountry patrol, trail & facility maintenance, Outfitter/Guide camp inspections, campsite clean-up & naturalization, supervise trail interns.

**Animal Packer:** stationed at a remote station, work independently, animal packing in rough mountainous terrain, travel with a 6-8 animal string utilizing all necessary hitches and techniques, hold stock in backcountry up to 10 days utilizing pickets and hobbles, for loose grazing, basic farrier work, animal husbandry, equipment care, trailering, and station maintenance.

**Schedule:** Backpack to work sites, 10 days on in the field, 4 days off at duty station.

**Housing:** Wilderness techs and Trail Crew at a remote backcountry station with limited facilities. Housing for Weed Crew may be available in McCall.

**Pay:** depends on experience GS-03 ~ \$12.19; GS-04 ~ \$13.68; GS-05 ~ \$15.31
