Founded in 2005, the Selway Bitterroot Frank Church Foundation is a regional non-profit organization with a mission to connect citizens and communities to provide stewardship for the Selway-Bitterroot Wilderness and Frank Church-River of No Return Wilderness areas through boots on the ground work, education and partnerships. SBFC is accepting applications for a Program Director who will provide coordination, oversight and development for SBFC wilderness stewardship programs across the 4 million acre wilderness complex. The position is responsible for developing, coordinating, planning, managing and leading annual programs of staff and volunteer work in a collaborative partnership with the U. S. Forest Service and wilderness managers on the Bitterroot, Nez Perce-Clearwater, Payette and Salmon-Challis National Forests.

LOCATION

The Program Director position is located in Missoula, Montana and is a fulltime, salaried position with a generous benefits package.

REQUIRED SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

- Experience in coordinating, working with and leading community partners, volunteers, interns and SBFC staff to safely accomplish wilderness stewardship projects in backcountry settings.
- Experience in volunteer program management and working with geographically disbursed teams.
- Supervisory experience and understanding of risk management.
- Skills and experience with tool cache management, traditional tools and techniques, including crosscut saw, hand tools, pack stock, rock work and wilderness trail specifications.
- Experience in planning and coordinating multi-day backcountry projects .
- Ability to travel regularly in Montana and Idaho, year-round, on multi-day trips in front and back country settings.
- Ability to manage spreadsheets, reporting and budgeting.
- Understanding of the Wilderness Act, the US Forest Service and non-profit management.
- A high level of physical fitness and ability to lift 50 pounds or more and walk 15 or more miles daily in a backcountry setting, carrying a fully loaded backpack and tools.
